

Fundraising at St John's School

At St John the Baptist Primary School we encourage our students to become aware that there are others, both locally, nationally and internationally who are in need of help. We seek to enlighten our students on how they can make a difference to the lives of these people, through sharing their talents and treasures.

We run a number of different fundraising activities for different charities and causes.

Free Dress Days – Each term, we have two free dress days and students are asked to contribute a gold coin donation to go towards the selected cause. Mid-term free dress days raise funds for a variety of different charities selected. Monies raised at the End of term free dress days go to Caritas.

Special Appeals– We ask students and school community members for donations for special causes when needed e.g. bushfire or flood victims; a family with a special need

Special Causes – At times, we choose to raise funds for special causes e.g. Day for Daniel

Project Compassion – Term 1 each year is devoted to raising funds across all year levels for Project Compassion.

Stewardship focuses for particular Year levels – As part of our school Stewardship Program, particular year levels raise funds to donate to set causes e.g. Year Sevens raise funds for a Marist run mission school in the Philippines; Year Threes raise funds for the local turtle sanctuary;
