

Liturgies

- Multiple opportunities are provided throughout the year for teachers to prepare and celebrate Liturgies of the Eucharist and the Word both in the church and at school.
- Prep to Year 2 classes celebrate Liturgies of the Word while Years 3 to 7 classes, celebrate Liturgies of the Eucharist.
- All combined year levels organise one liturgy a year at the Star of the Sea church.
- All classes organise and celebrate one liturgy at school per year
- We seek to ensure all students have experiences of Church even though we are removed from the Church building location.

- 24 July – the birth of St John the Baptist
- Week 3 Term 3 Catholic Education Week

- ANZAC Day
- Stations of the Cross in the last week of Term 1
- NAIDOC Week
